Title III report – Joan Warburg U of O Sustainable City Year Program Approval of Superintendent Goals

COMMUNITY COMMENTS

Steve Swisher Ox Yoke Sisters, OR 97759

Steve encouraged Board members to understand the tax levy timeline and to fill budget committee openings sooner than later. He also encouraged members to become "experts" by giving assignments to get committee members engaged in the community and their role. He would like Board members to "think outside the box" by considering community partnerships, i.e. fire dept, police dept, and SPRD employees, when it comes to appointing budget committee members.

ADMINISTRATORS REPORT

Joan Warburg ~ SES

Joan informed the Board members that she has submitted the required State of Oregon English Learners in Oregon report. Sisters has 4 students that exited the EL program this year. She mentioned that the SES summer school program ended today, which included 5 weeks of programming and interventions based on grade and skill level. SES also offered a camp for any parents that may have had difficulty with child care over the summer. Joan wanted to thank the community partners who contributed to the summer school program.

Tim Roth ~ SMS

Tim would like to invite all Board Members to the middle school on September 6 at 4:30pm for an open house BBQ. This will include a time for parents get to meet the teachers as well. The middle school ran a summer school program also this summer mostly in August. Summer programs included math, art, and a culinary camp. The middle school is hoping to start a hiking camp soon. All of the programs were made possible by grants.

Steve Stancliff ~ SHS

Steve also invited the Board to an Open House on September 26th that will include a mock schedule for parents to follow and meet teachers. The high school's summer school program had 40 students participating. The conventional summer school program includes credit recovery or getting ahead to clear up room in their future schedule. Most of the student's worked remotely from home. Steve was excited to announce that the high school was able to leverage grant funds to purchase 4 new vacuum presses for the luthier program which will allow more students to complete guitar projects at a much quicker rate. A handful of students worked on their guitars over the summer as well.

Lorna Van Geem ~ Special Programs

12 SSD students completed the summer work program. The program is designed to help with with job skills. The district also ran ESY program that included 14 students that show regression because of extended breaks. This is different then summer school because it focuses specifically on skills directly related to goals on their IEPs.

BOND UPDATE

Superintendent Scholl is hoping for a ground breaking ceremony in October. The transition center is being moved from its current location to behind the high school.
