CALL TO ORDER / FLAG SALUTE

Call to Order Jeff Smith called the Regular Board Meeting to order at 6:00pm.

GUEST PRESENTERS

Seed to Table

Audrey Tehan presented the partnership that Seed to Table has with the Sisters School District, which is currently in it's 11th year of collaboration. Seed to Table offers over 900 student visits to the farm each year and comes to visit the schools twice a year (winter and spring). Over the years, Seed to Table has established a close collaboration with the teachers and students, including staff workshops and greenhouse experiments, as well as a highly impactful relationship with the life skill students at the high school and middle school. Learning opportunities range from gaining a better understanding of biology, plant ecosystems, planting and harvesting, to nutrition and fresh foods, preparation of healthy meals and taste testing.

BUSINESS / FINANCE REPORTS

Revenue / Expenditures Sherry Joseph shared the <u>2024-03-06 General Fund Report</u> and the <u>2024-03-06 General Fund Projected</u>

vs Actual Report. Sherry asked the Board if they had any questions. Clarifications were made about

the contingency funds.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS / QUESTIONS / ANNOUNCEMENTS

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Enrollment Report Curt Scholl shared that this month's enrollment report reflects corrections of past errors due to

improper Synergy report manipulation. Enrollment numbers have actually been rather stable for the past several months. This is probably due to high interest rates and a slowed housing market.

Bond Update Curt Scholl shared that the elementary school construction has encountered some delays due to the

winter weather. The first floor is moving faster than the second floor. No great impact on the move-in

date is expected. A staff tour will be planned for the end of April.

Roundabout Curt Scholl shared that the roundabout construction has begun and ODOT mentioned that they are on

target for a traffic flip for Memorial Day weekend.

Parks & Recreation Collaboration Curt Scholl shared that the lease agreement is moving forward with the SPRD and Treehouse

Therapies. Conversations have also been held with a 0 to 3 year-old childcare service. Many spaces

are expected to be leased by August / September.

Workforce Housing Update Curt Scholl shared that the second candidate is in the final stages of approval. It was suggested that

for eventual future workforce housing we perform a general survey of needs in order to best

accommodate and support staff.

BOARD BUSINESS

14 Hours Missed Instructional Time Curt Scholl presented the governor's waiver of 14 hours of missed instructional time. For this year,

due to two snow days and four delayed starts, this waiver would benefit mainly the seniors and third

and fourth grade, who are very tight on hours.

Jeff moved and Edie seconded that the Board accept the governor's waiver of 14 hours missed instructional time. Vote was in favor.

Motion passed 3-2.

Budget Committee Recruitment Curt Scholl shared that we have three openings for the budget committee, and for the moment we

have only two candidates (one is a renewal). Other candidates may submit candidacy soon. Interviews

will be scheduled before the next board meeting.

HDESD Rep Recruitment Curt Scholl shared that we have a candidate to perhaps replace Edie as representative of Sisters

School District on the HDESD School Board.
