

Student Fundraising Activities

All fundraising must be approved by the superintendent or designee and supervised by the appropriate advisor.

Fundraising projects involving the sale of products must be approved by the activity sponsor and by the principal before the activity is initiated.

The board recognizes the important role of fundraising in support of extracurricular activities and classroom resources. However, since classroom instructional time is vitally important to the educational mission of the district, fundraising activities must occur outside regular class time.

Further guidelines are:

1. All fundraising activities for school related activities will be approved in advance by the building administrator;
2. Extended fundraising aimed at one particular group, organization or business will be discouraged. The athletic director and principal will oversee fundraising activities to avoid donor fatigue;
3. Students participating in any school-related fundraising activities will conduct themselves in accordance with the district's student conduct code;
4. Fundraising activities are permitted before and after school, during lunch and other non-class times. They are not permitted to interfere with or interrupt the class time of other students, teachers or staff.
5. Fundraising activities cannot compete with Nutritional Services. In addition, if food items are sold they must comply with the current Oregon nutrition standards law ORS 336.423.
