

Admission of Exchange Students

In the interest of furthering better understanding and improving human relations among district students and youth from all parts of the world, the Board encourages Sisters High School to participate in student foreign exchange programs.

Exchange students must meet the same regulations and expectations of resident students, including the immunization requirements.

At the time of admission the exchange students must be at least 15 years old but not older than 19 years of age and possess a reasonable knowledge of the English language.

Exchange students will be subject to all policies and regulations governing the conduct and behavior of resident students.

A high school diploma may be awarded at regular commencement exercises to all foreign exchange students who successfully meet the necessary requirement during the year in which they attend.

Exchange students will be encouraged to participate in all student activities, and will be eligible to participate in interscholastic athletics, provided academic requirements and Oregon School Activities Association criteria are met.

The Board reserves the right to limit the number of exchange students in a given year.

In the case of all request for admission of foreign exchange students to Sisters High School in the district, the administrative procedures will be followed.
